As opposed to giving students an aggregate knowledge in many areas of development, graduates of the ICT University program acquire theoretical and practical knowledge and appropriation of a compendium of analytical skills for undertaking development planning and development management, in any field from the vantage point of an interdisciplinary background and use this to plan. Thus, every core course of the program is conceived to have both theory and practical components. It builds skills, especially in relation to research, leadership and working with groups and in the planning, management and evaluation of development projects. ***There is a focus on result oriented development planning.***

What will a graduate of the ICT University MSC in Development Planning do after graduating?

The MSC in Development Planning is indeed, designed to prepare graduates for work in the public and private sectors as specialists in development (development policy analysis, policy formulation and policy implementation).

As a specialist in development planning you become an asset in bringing added value for service with government institutions (including the local government or councils) but also for the private sector such as industries, corporations and NGOs. **You come in with any first degree and acquire proven marketable skills in development planning.**

PROGRAM OBJECTIVES

To offer a high quality academic and professional training in development planning, examining contemporary theories in the social sciences and development policies and practices.

▶ To equip participants with a theoretical understanding of debates relating to development, including contrasting arguments and understandings of development processes, and to enhance their abilities to apply such knowledge to policy analysis and practical problem solving.

▶ To enhance the skills of participants, especially in relation to leadership, motivation and working with groups and in the planning, management and evaluation of development projects.

▶ To enhance participants' understanding of social research on contemporary issues in the development field and to facilitate learners to critically analyze these issues in the light of their own primary research and development experience.

This program is also offered through part time and flexible and distance learning options.
