The underwriter analyzes, with a high level of technical expertise, exposures to loss, develops an adequate premium charge for the exposure, and determines appropriate endorsements and exclusions to address loss exposures for the insurance contract. The underwriter continually analyzes premium and loss results in their territory by agency, state, major class of industry and by line of business.
